To be able to use Office365 to sign into Vitec MV's products a few things need to be done

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
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Create an app in the AD

An app needs to be created in the AD.

Creating the app

Azure portal home -> App registrations -> New registration

Front-channel logout URL

This is where we send a request to have the application clear the user's session data. This is required for single sign-out to work correctly.

Change the identifierUris

Next the identifierUris needs to be changed.

Click on the "edit manifest" under Manage



Scroll down to the line 13: `"identifierUris": [`
